Standard Adult Safeguarding Course

This course is developed to give all who work, volunteer, or have contact with adults at risk, their partners and/or families; an introduction to safeguarding and to raise awareness of:

- * Legislation and guidance
- * The recognition of adult abuse
- * How to respond to concerns
- * Who to contact when there is a concern
- * Fulfilling "duty of care"
- * Safe practice and keeping adults at risk safe

Upon the successful completion of this course participants will be able to:

1. Describe appropriately the signs and symptoms of the possible abuse or neglect of the adults at risk with whom they come into contact.
2. Explain which individuals, organisations and reference documents they should refer to, and take advice from, if concerned about an adult at risk's wellbeing.
3. Describe how to evaluate risk when considering whether or not to request consent to share information about an adult at risk with the statutory authorities.
